MEMORANDUM.

Mr. Cory,-

At the last meeting of the Historic Sites and Monuments Board, held on the 15th of October last, a tentative list of military sites were reviewed, with a view to deciding which of these sites are of national importance and should be dealt with. The site of Chrysler's Farm Monument, Dundas County, Province of Ontario was one of those deemed of national importance.

The site covers an area of .23 acres, and a monument was erected by the Canadian Government in 1895, to commemorate the victory over the Americans at the Battle of Chrysler's Farm, 11th November, 1813, somewhat similar to that of Chateauguy.

The site is fenced and the monument is in a good state of preservation.

On the 23rd ultimo, the Deputy Minister of Militia and Defence advised the Department that he is now prepared to recommend to the Privy Council the transfer of this property for preservation, and I, therefore, recommend that the site be taken over by this Department as an historic site.
