Re: Chrysler's Farm.

Brig. Gen. F.A. Cruikshank, Mr. Mills and myself had occasion to visit the site of Chrysler's Farm. The plot of land is kept in a first class condition. The guns and the chain fence have been painted, and the site generally has a very splendid appearance.

The Page wire fence surrounding the site should be painted.
