**COMMEMORATIVE CEREMONIES TO THE 150th ANNIVERSARY
OF THE BATTLE OF CRYSLER'S FARM**

On Wednesday, July 17, 1963, commemorative ceremonies to the 150th Anniversary of the Battle of Crysler's Farm will take place at Crysler Farm Battle Park, seven miles east of Morrisburg. The program will be one and a half hours in duration, commencing at 2:30 p.m., and the theme will be "150 years of peace".

Dignitaries from Ontario and the United States will be in attendance with addresses by Premier John P. Robarts, Q.C., L.L.D., and Governor Nelson Rockefeller of New York State.

Five plaques will be unveiled and dedicated - to the 150th Anniversary of the Battle of Crysler's Farm, to the British 49th and 89th Regiments of Foot, to the Battle of Crysler's Farm, and to the great Indian Chief, Tecumseh.

Units of regiments that fought in the Battle of Crysler's Farm along with representatives of the Indian Nations will participate in the march past - the Princess Louise Dragoon Guard, Les Voltigeurs de Quebec, the Brockville Rifles, and the Stormont-Dundas-Glengarry Highlanders. Junior Choirs will lead in the singing of "O Canada", in English and French, and "My Country 'Tis of Thee", closing with "God Save the Queen".

A cordial invitation is extended to the public to be present on this historic occasion.
